Hessett Parish Council Play Area Survey

To ascertain the numbers of children that are both residents and visitors of Hessett village the Parish Council created a "Play Area Survey" form. See appendix 1.

The answers given via this form are to enable the P.C. to put in a claim for S106 monies for the refurbishment of the existing play facilities.

The form's aim was to gather information on the numbers, gender and age of these children as well as to show a need for the refurbishment of the existing play facilities in the village. The survey form was distributed to all properties within the village boundary to be later collected within a two week period by both members of Hessett P.C. and volunteers.

The number of properties surveyed was **205** with returned responses from **133**. This gave a percentage return of **65%**. The total numbers of surveys distributed and the responses returned by individual roads are shown in the chart below.

From the surveys that were returned **36** households said that they had children under the age of 16 residing with them. This is **18%** of the households in the village.

The surveys also showed that **72** households had children that visited them during the year. This is **35%** of household in the village.

The full answers to all the survey forms are shown on a spread sheet. See appendix 2.

The following pages show a breakdown of the figures supplied on the survey forms. It should be noted that there are discrepancies between the different charts due to information missing from some areas of the survey forms. To ensure fairness all information has been included.

For example a form ticked children but did not give ages or gender. It did however tick other information boxes. This information has been included in the relevant charts.

Children Residing In The Village

The survey showed the number of children that reside in the village as **61**. From the information provided a breakdown by both gender and age was obtained.

Of the **54** children who answered this question only **20 (37%)** used the existing play area on a daily or weekly basis.

The existing play area caters for children up to the age of 12. The previous chart shows that the village has **34** children between the ages of a 0 and 11 (*children under one were counted as one year olds*).

If the existing play area was refurbished within the next 12 months then those children would benefit. This equates to **63%** of the total village children who can benefit from refurbishment.

At present the only play facilities for children over 12 are five aside football nets on a grassy area and a standalone netball post and net on grass.

The survey shows that we have **16** children between **13** and **16**, 26% of the total children who are too old to use the facilities in the existing play area.

We also asked the resident children between the ages of 1 and 12 years of age if they would use the play area more often when it is refurbished. The results are shown below.

From the **145** only **63 (43%)** visited daily, weekly or at weekends. The remainder visited monthly or less per year.
